What to bring with you to Tax SuperSaturday or a VITA/AARP site:

- Picture ID and social security card
- Social Security cards for your children or other dependents in your household.
- If you are married, your spouse must be present to file jointly.
- All tax forms you received (W2, 1099, 1095, 1098)
- Information on cash employment income, self employed business expenses, childcare expenses, education expenses, medical expenses, home mortgage and charitable giving.
- Your prior year tax return, if available.
- Bring your patience: *preparing your taxes takes time; depending on turnout, there may be wait times as well.*
