Become a tax assistance volunteer.

Last year over 725 volunteers prepared more than 16,000 tax returns, generating more than \$20 million in refunds back to families in our Greater Cincinnati region.

As a volunteer tax preparer, you can have a major impact on the well-being of local families. Your time and knowledge are worth thousands in tax prep fees and additional refunds as you assist hardworking local families to file their taxes and claim educational and family credits.



Learn how to assist families at volunteer income tax assistance sites throughout Greater Cincinnati:

- Volunteers work weekends and evenings at sites in Ohio, Kentucky and Indiana.
- You can volunteer as an individual or in a team.
- Volunteers generally work four 4-hour shifts during the tax season, January-April.
- No math or tax experience is needed; training and certification is provided; IRS certified volunteers acting within the scope of the program are protected from liability.
- Attorneys FPAs, and CPAs can earn up to 18 Continuing Education Credits for training and volunteer service.
